To carry out all relevant administration tasks including care plans, risk assessments and case notes.

This post is for forty hours a week including some evenings and weekends. Some travelling is required within the local area. To start asap, or with effect from June 2019.

Salary range: £20,683 - £24,233. (Part time working considered for the right candidate.)

## Estate Team Leader

To supervise work teams of residents on the Yeldall estate, and participate in the general running of the Yeldall Manor programme. You must be willing and able to work outside and engage in physical work alongside the residents, providing guidance and motivation, ensuring the safety of those working with you. Personal maturity is vital; skills and experience in gardening and/or property maintenance are a bonus.
